The Indian Kayaking and Canoeing Association is pleased to allot the All India Open Canoe Sprint Championships Senior & Junior (Men & Women) to M.P Amateur Kayaking and Canoeing Association at Lower Lake Bhopal.

There will be five All India Open Championships round the year. The Ranking or Athletes will declared by IKCA. The M.P Amateur kayaking and Canoeing Association at Lower Lake Bhopal will provide free Boats, Venue, Course, Drinking water and Security.

Each State is allowed to field teams in 200 and 500 mtrs distances K-1,K-2, C-1, C-2, K-4, and C-4(for Junior & Senior Men and Women).

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The Eligibility certificate must be signed by the Secretary/President of State Association.
- 2. The Certificate of each athlete from Birth & Death directorate of Govt. to be submitted in Original.
- 3. The Medical certificates for age proof have to be submitted by the athletes duly signed by Govt. District Hospital form Medical board.
- 4. Entry Fee Rs 300 per head per event.
- 5. Registration fee and federation fee Rs 100 per head.
- 6. The IKCA, MPKCA, or Technical Committee will not held responsible for any damage or causality (The indemnity Board to be submitted)
- 7. The athlete must know the swimming and rescue of self, boat and equipment.
