

ACTC 2022-2023 for KAYAKING & CANOEING

Date: 29th March, 2022

Minutes of ACTC meeting held on 24th March, 2022: Indian Kayaking & Canoeing Association (IKCA)

A meeting to finalize the Annual Calendar for Training and Competition for Kayaking & Canoeing for the year 2022-23 was held on 24th March 2022 under the chairpersonship of Smt. Sujata Chaturvedi, Secretary (Sports) MYA&S at the Conference Hall, Sports Authority of India HQ, New Delhi. The list of participants is annexed.


2. At the outset, Hon. Secretary General, IKCA listed the projected targets for players including Asian Games 2022. IKCA submitted following measurable outcomes:

3. IKCA presented the plans for the National Coaching Camps and Foreign Exposures for events leading to Asian Games 2022 in September. The budget summary was presented thereafter in accordance with the revised norms for funding under Assistance to NSF Scheme.

4. Hon. Secretary General, IKCA made following commitments, which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget:

- 4.1 Gender Budgeting to be done so as to ensure equal expenditure for Men and Women.
- 4.2 Strengthening and capacity building in National Camps through inclusion of Sports Science Staff and ensuring scientific evaluation of campers and targeted interventions thereof. Data management of the performance evaluations be ensured.
- 4.3 Maintaining a proper system of utilisation of government grants under the scheme.
- 4.4 Displaying on website of IKCA of all grants received under the scheme.

4.5 Strict compliance of WADA Code and NADA rules, details of educational plans for athletes and display of Anti-Doping awareness programmes on their respective websites.

5. The calendar and budget were considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The total budget for the annual calendar for training and competition was approved for IKCA up to March, 2023 with a cap of **Rs. 3.50 Crores**, of this 10% is earmarked for contingencies and 3% for administrative expenses of the NSF as per the latest norms of MYAS dated 28th February 2022. It is emphasized that NSF will allocate adequate budget as demanded for Asian Games 2022 & ensure that the all needs of athletes as projected under ACTC are fulfilled.

6. The budget is approved for the following requirements:

6.1 National Coaching Camp for Men & Women (Senior)

Placed at Annexure – II.

6.2 International Competition/ Exposure (Senior& Juniors)

Foreign Exposure in senior across all events should be with a focused approach on targeted events where there are realistic medal chances and with commensurate exposures to the Junior Group.


6.3 Remuneration - Indian Coaches & Support Staff


The names and salaries of the coaches and support staff to be empaneled for the National Coaching Camp shall be approved separately by the Empanelment Committee by **30.04.2022**.

7. The proposed Annual Calendar for Training & Competition was approved within the approved budgetary ceiling as stated at Para 5. A review would be undertaken after Asian Games 2022, in the month of October 2022, based on the achievements of Asian Games, 2022, for any additional requirement of funds subject to availability of budget under the 'Assistance to NSF' Scheme.

8. Modifications to the calendar can be made by NSF with the approval by DG SAI within the overall approved budget. It is reiterated that all the guidelines mentioned in MYAS circular dated 28th Feb will be adhered to.


9. Secretary (Sports) emphasised on the following aspects:

 - IKCA would finalize its selection policy which would be notified on its website.




